

# Transport statistics

## May, 2018

**Tirana June 2018:** The volume of freight loading/unloading in ports, in May 2018 is 365 thousand / tonnes decreasing 6.3 % compared to May 2017.

In the first five months 2018, the volume of freight loading/unloading in ports is 1.663 thousand/tonnes, increasing by 2.6 % compared to the same period of year 2017.

The volume of freight transported by rail is 2,316 thousand tonnes–kilometer decreasing by 27.6 % compared to May 2017.

In the first five 2018, volume of freights transported by rail is 6.716 thousand tonnes-km, decreased by 33.1 % compared with the same period of 2017.

In the first five months 2018, the volume of freightst transported by is 900 tonnes, decreasing by 0.8 % compared to the same period of year 2017.

In May 2018, number of flights is 2,044 marking an increasing by 12.2 %, compared to May 2017.

The number of passengers traveling by sea line in May I 2018 is 105.210 passengers, compared to May 2017, this indicator increasing by 10.4 %.

In the first five months of 2018, 312,551 passengers traveled by sea, decreased 9.5 % compared to the same period a previous year .

In the first five months 2018, passenger air transport occupies 74.7 % of the total transport. The number of passengers traveling by line i n the first five months of 2018 is 992,6236 persons, increasing by 11.4 % compared to the same period of year 2017.

### Exports/Imports of goods by mode of transport

In May 2018, the value of goods traded (exports and imports) is 87 billion lekë and 53.0 % of them is transported by sea.

In the first five months of 2018, vlera the value of goods traded (exports and imports) is 387 billion lekë and 54.6 % of them is transported by sea.

### Exports of goods

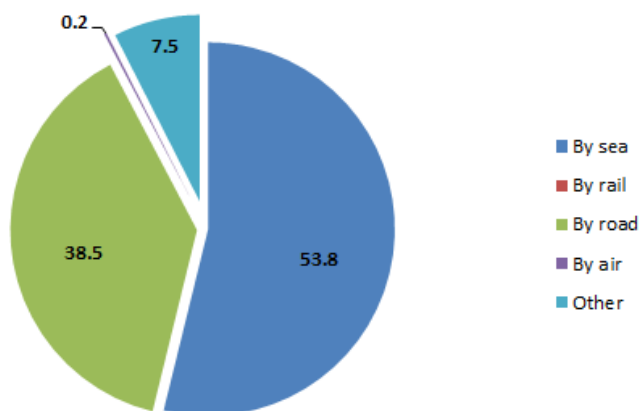
In May 2018, goods exported by sea represent 53.8 %, by road 38.5 % and by air 0.2 % of total exports of goods.

Goods exported by road, in May 2018, increased by 22.2 % while by rail decreasing 80.7 %, compared with May 2017.

In the first five months of 2018, goods exported by sea represent 59.1 %, by road 33.8 % and by air 0.4 %.

Goods exported by road, in the first four months of 2018, increased by 16.5 % and by air 9.1 %, compared with a same period of previous year.

### Imports of goods

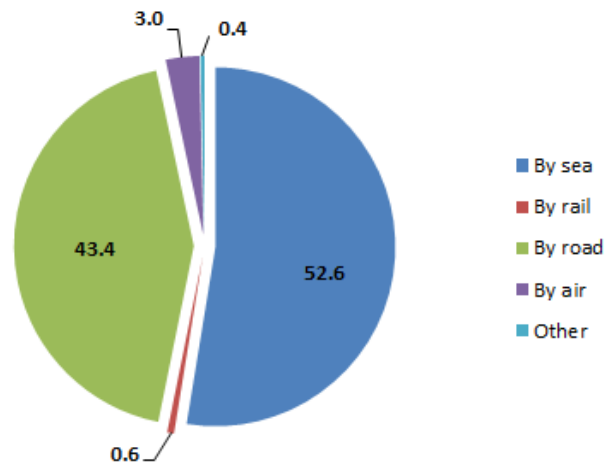
In May 2018, goods imported by sea represent 52.6 %, by road 43.4 % and by air 3.0 %.

Goods imported by rail increased by 22.1 % and by road increased 1.3 %, compared with May 2017.

In the first five months of 2018, goods imported by sea represent 52.3 %, by road 42.5 % and by air 2.9 %.

Goods imported by sea, in the first five months of 2018, increased by 11.0 % while by rail decreased by 16.8 %, compared with a same period of previous year.

# Methodology

## Definitions

**Airlines** include companies that transporting passengers and goods.

**Transport:** Movement of people and / or freights using various means of transport. Transport July be carried out by land, air and sea means.

**Rail transport: Every** movement of freights and / passengers using wheeled vehicles run on the track.

**Maritime transport:** Any movement of goods and / or passengers using commercial vessel trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by sea.

**Air transport:** Any movement of freights and / or passengers using aircraft on trips, which are undertaken wholly or partly by air.

**Exports** are goods destined to a third country, placed under customs export or outward processing arrangements or re-exported following inward processing.

**The FOB (free on board)** value of exports of goods is the value of the goods at the exporter's customs frontier.

**Imports** are goods arrived from a third country and are directly placed, or are left in warehouse, under customs procedure of release for free circulation, inward processing or processing under customs control.

**The cost, insurance and freight (CIF)** price is the price of a good delivered at the frontier of the importing country, or the price of a service delivered to resident, before the payment of any import duties or other taxes on imports or trade and transport margins within the country.

**Standard Goods Classification for Transport Statistics (NST2007)** is a goods nomenclature used mainly for transports statistics

**Sorce data:** The data are provided by the Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure aand General Directorate of Customs
